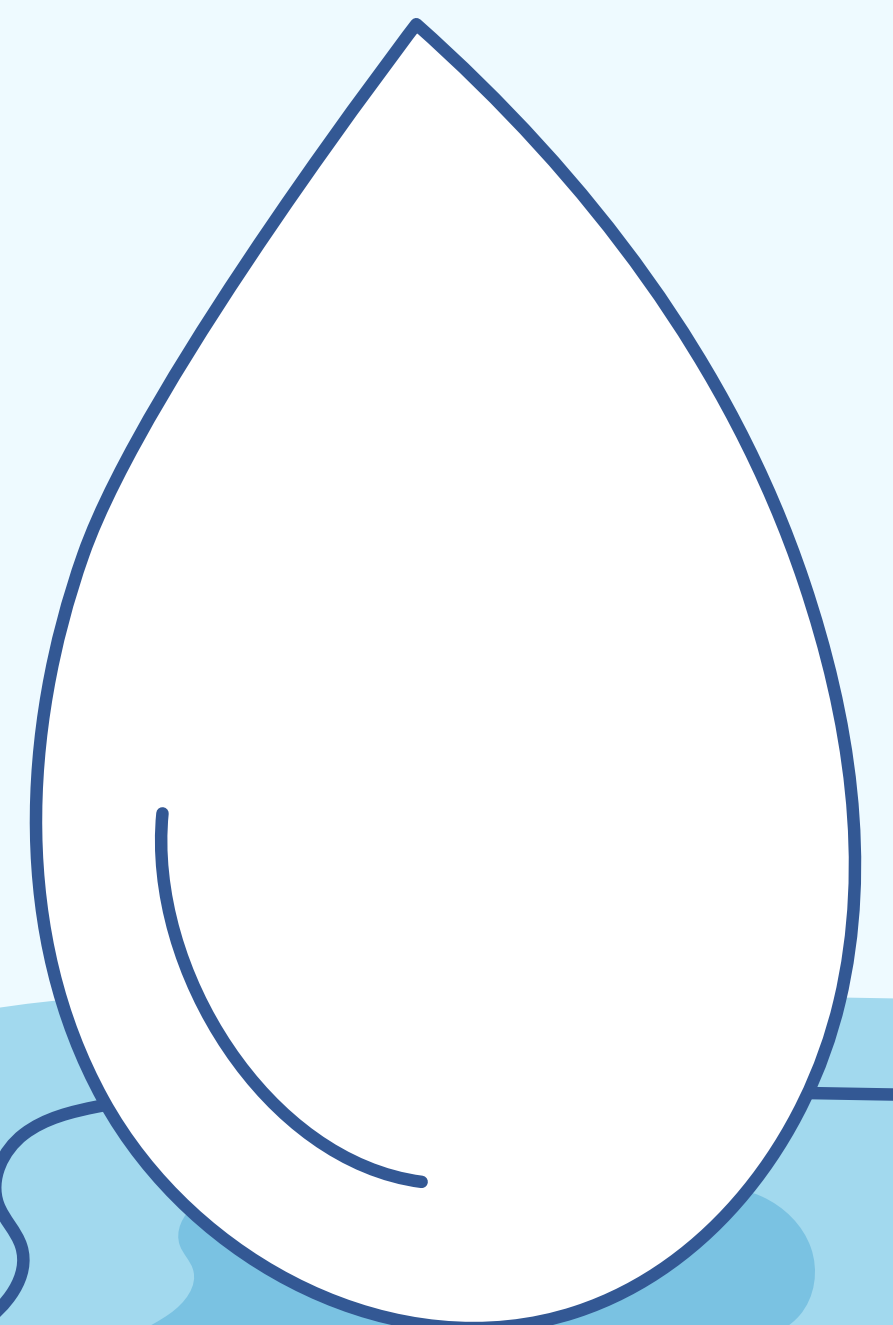

- 5 Points Full of information I can use

- 3 Points Learned some things
- ≤ 2 Points Pretty light on details

Presenter

- 5 Points Well spoken, very knowledgeable of topic
- 4 Points Knew topic, but presentation skills are average
- 3 points Average presenter, average knowledge of topic
- ≤ 2 Points Hesitant, unsure of facts

Layout

- 5 Points Poster layout added to understanding
- 3 Points Average readability, layout doesn't follow the flow
- ≤ 1 Point Jumbled layout, unreadable text

Bottom line

- 5 Points Should be presented at WEF
- 4 Points Good, solid presentation
- 3 Points It was OK
- ≤ 2 Points Not up to competing at the national level
